

Scholarships are available from many sources to help student's meet basic educational costs. Awards are made on the basis of financial need and academic ability. Scholarship awards vary from tuition scholarships to full (tuition, fees, books and supplies) scholarships. Freshman/New student early application deadline is April 1, 2011. The sophomore/returning student early application deadline is May 1, 2011. Students can apply on-line. See How Do I Apply? Web address is listed above.

The Federal Work-Study provides part-time employment to unemployed students demonstrating financial need. Students work on campus in jobs related to their major if possible. The current pay rate is **\$7.25** to **\$7.50** per hour with a \$2,400 per year maximum. This pay rate is subject to change without notice.
