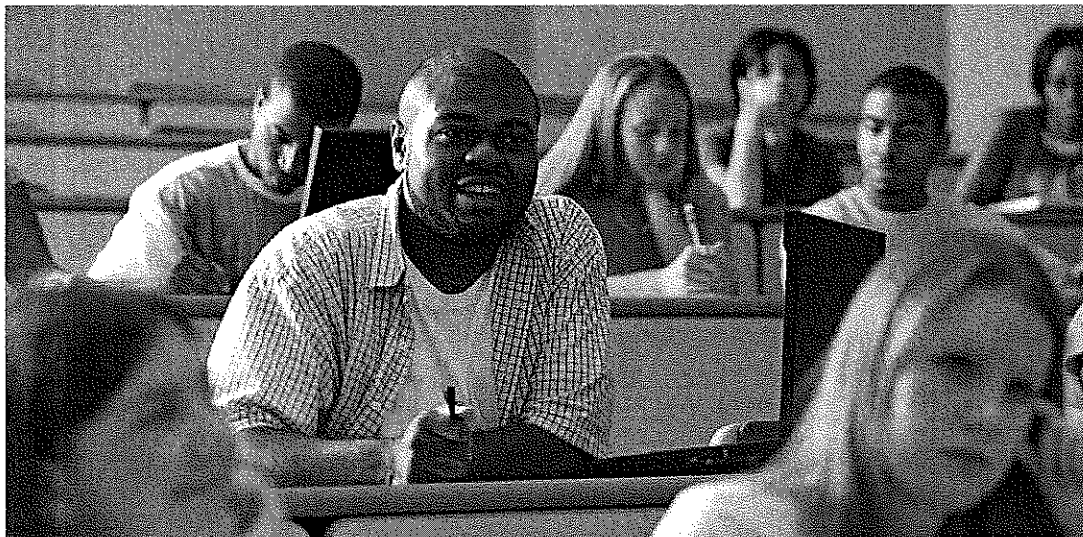
- 2011 federal tax returns (for you and your parents)
