- General Education Development (GED) official scores
- State certificate stating you have passed a state-authorized examination recognized as an equivalent of high school diploma.
- Academic transcript of a successfully completed two-year program acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- If you are a home schooled, a transcript or equivalent, signed by parent or guardian, listing secondary school courses you have completed and documentation that you have successfully completed secondary school education.
- If you are a home-schooled student, a secondary school completion credential provided under state law.
- If you do not have documentation meeting any of the above requirements, seeking a diploma or associate degree and excelled academically in high school, you may provide documentation of the high school stating that you excelled academically in high school and documentation from your current/future post-secondary institution that you have met the formalized, written policies of admitting such students.
