The WCC presidential finalists are (in alphabetical order):

Micheal Rodgers, Ed.D., is the Chief Institutional Officer and Director of the Foundation of Owensboro Community and Technical College in Owensboro, KY. He previously served as the Vice President of Advancement and Executive Director of the Foundation also at Owensboro Community and Technical College in Owensboro, KY. Dr. Rodgers earned a Doctor of Education in Higher Education Leadership from Maryville University; A Masters of arts in Organizational Leadership from Western Kentucky University; A Bachelors in Chemistry from the University of South Carolina-Aiken; and an Associate Degree of Applied Science in Automotive Technology from Piedmont Technical College in Greenwood South Carolina.

Carolyn Strickland, Ph.D., was Vice President of Enrollment Management and Associate Provost at Pennsylvania College of Technology in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. She previously served as Assistant Vice President of Academic Affairs at Pennsylvania College of Technology in Williamsport, PA. Dr. Strickland earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Educational Psychology from The Pennsylvania State University in State College, Pennsylvania; a Master of Education in Student Personnel Services from the University of South Carolina in Columbia, South Carolina; and a Bachelor of Science in Psychology and Urban Studies from the University of Pittsburgh in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Public forums will take place the week of January 8 and each candidate will participate in a 1-hour forum. We invite and encourage everyone to participate in the open forums. Forums will be made accessible to all faculty, administrators, staff, students, and the general public.
